On Monday, May 4, 2020, I shared my disappointment regarding the order that closed our school building for the remainder of the school year for the health and safety of our students, staff, and community. During the past few days, we have been working on plans to recognize our seniors. Dr. Handerhan sent our seniors an email and let them know that the first part of our recognition will take place this evening, and that we are moving forward with plans for an onsite graduation subject pending approval by the NJDOE.

Equally important is our focus on supporting learning for all students, I've asked teachers to move any live video sessions from "optional" to "mandatory" in an effort to increase engagement among students. (Students who are unable to participate will be provided with an alternate assignment.) Teachers who are using live video will schedule one or more
