RUMSON-FAIR HAVEN EXCELLENCE

Rumson-Fair Haven Regional High School is accredited by the NJ Department of Education, it is a comprehensive high school of nearly 800 students in grades 9-12.

- In 2025, RFH was recognized by *US News and World Report* among the top 4% of high schools in the US and the best high school in Monmouth County, New Jersey.
- In the 2024-2025 school year, 98% of our students participated in extracurricular activities and/or athletics.
- In 2025, 35 seniors, representing 13 different sports, committed to play NCAA athletics.
- In 2025, *Common Sense*, the national nonprofit organization dedicated to helping kids and families thrive in a world of media and technology, recognized Rumson-Fair Haven Regional High School as a *Common Sense* School.
- In 2025, RFH was recognized by the College Board with the Gold AP Honor Roll distinction, based off number of overall tests taken.

RFH operates on a **rotating, block (57 minute) full year schedule** with the option of semester-based offerings. This option provides opportunities for deeper instructional engagement and fosters greater time-management and independence amongst our students, preparing them for the reality of a college schedule.

Honors, Advanced Placement, Dual Credit and Dual Enrollment courses are weighted by one additional quality point in **GPA** calculation.

Our students continue to seek the **most challenging of post secondary options** and the **rigor of AP, Honors, Dual Credit, and Dual Enrollment courses**. Their academic quality is further supported by standardized test scores noted on the following page of this profile.

All courses taken at RFH (9-12) are included in GPA. Credits earned in other schools, enrichment programs and summer school grades are listed on the transcript but are not included in GPA calculations.

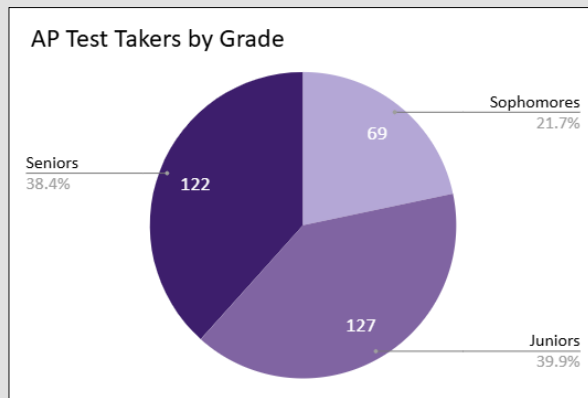
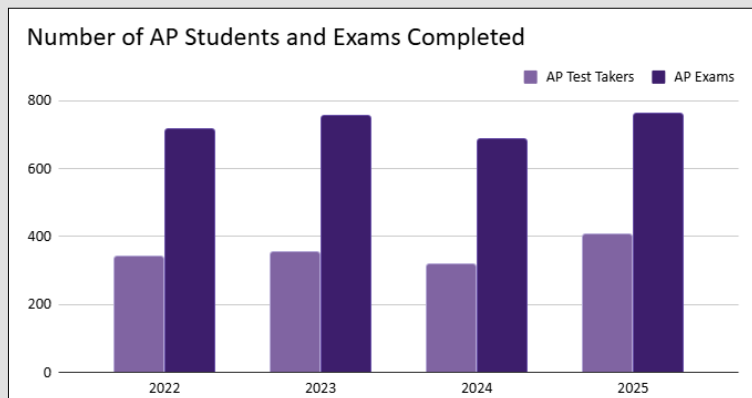
