- Requirement for Class of '26 Graduation Requirement
- Designed to measure the extent to which students are graduation-ready in ELA and Math
 - ELA-aligned to grade 10 standards with a focus on writing effectively when analyzing text
 - Math-aligned to Algebra I and Geometry standards with a focus on applying skills and concepts and understanding multi-step problems that require abstract reasoning and modeling real-world problems, precision, perseverance, and strategic use of tools
- Students demonstrate their acquired skills and knowledge by answering selected-response items, constructed response items, and technology-enhanced questions.
- Administered to all 11th Graders on Monday, March 10th and Tuesday, March 11th





RFH's NJGPA Results-ELA Historical (Spring 2025)









NJGPA-Future Implications (Spring 2025)

- 4 of 5 ELA students deemed "Not Graduation Ready" do not currently meet alternate NJDOE Graduation Pathways
- 7 of 15* Math students deemed "Not Graduation Ready" do not currently meet alternate NJDOE Graduation Pathways
- Students who scored between 700-724 will retest in the fall
- After the NJGPA Fall administration, students who have still failed to meet the 725 NJGPA threshold and haven't met the second pathways (PSAT, SAT or ACT scores)will go through the portfolio process to meet NJDOE graduation requirements
- Will discuss with staff to set goals for instruction; discussion will include analysis of standards that need improvement
