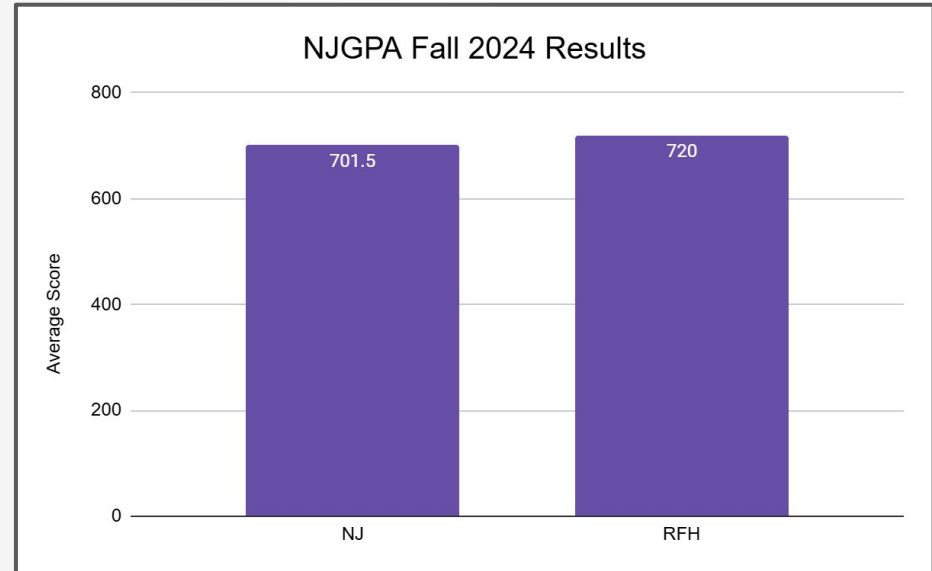


New Jersey Graduation Proficiency Assessment (NJGPA): Overview & Administration

- Make up administration–Class of '25 Graduation Requirement
- Designed to measure the extent to which students are graduation-ready in ELA and Math
 - ELA-aligned to grade 10 standards with a focus on writing effectively when analyzing text
 - Math-aligned to Algebra I and Geometry standards with a focus on applying skills and concepts and understanding multi-step problems that require abstract reasoning and modeling real-world problems, precision, perseverance, and strategic use of tools
- Students demonstrate their acquired skills and knowledge by answering selected-response items, constructed response items, and technology-enhanced questions.
- Administered to eleven 12th Graders on Tuesday, October 8th, 2024 and Wednesday, October 9th, 2024 (6 ELA, 7 Math)
- One out of district student tested and is also reported in our results.

RFH's NJGPA Results (Fall 2024)

NJGPA-Future Implications (Fall 2024)



- Of the 11 (in building)students who were tested:
 - 8 were deemed “graduation ready” or meet alternate pathways for the NJDOE Class of 2025 graduation requirement.
 - 3 were deemed “not graduation ready” in ELA and/or Mathematics and do not meet alternate pathways for the NJDOE Class of 2025 graduation requirement.
- Portfolios (1 in ELA and 4 in Mathematics) will be completed and submitted to meet graduation requirements
- Will discuss with staff to set goals for instructions; discussion will include analysis of standards that need improvement
