



Rumson-Fair Haven Regional High School Digital Days - Expectations

Students

In the event that RFH must close, teachers will ensure that instruction continues by providing online instruction through Google Classroom. Additionally, teachers will determine a method for interaction with students using an approved platform (Google Classroom questions, Google Hangout phone in conferences, Gmail school accounts). Students are expected to login to their Google Classrooms daily.

- Login to all classes every day using your RFH student Gmail.
- Students must be logged in 2 - 5 hours daily.
- Complete assignments daily.
- Participate in activities, such as posting answers to questions or collaborating online with peers.
- Complete assessments independently as directed by teachers.
- Ask for help by sending emails to teacher.
- Asynchronous participation is allowable; however daily interaction is required.
- Let all teachers know if you are sick and unable to participate.
- All RFH expectations for student behavior remain in effect. Students are reminded to exercise appropriate digital etiquette.

- **How do I participate?** Students must use their Google Classrooms to participate. Specific activities will be assigned by teachers.

- **How will the teacher know that I'm participating?** Use your rfhstudent.org email address when participating in class or sending questions to your teacher.

- **Do I need to be online at specific times for specific classes?** No. Your teachers will post assignments on Google Classroom with instructions and due dates/times. Please communicate with your teacher by using Google Classroom or your RFH Email Account. The expectation is that you log into your RFH email and Google Classroom each weekday and participate for 2 - 5 hours per day.

- **How do I hand in assignments?** Your teachers will post specific instructions for your assignments. Most teachers will utilize the Google Classroom platform and you will be able to submit assignments as you do during regular school assignments.

- **What do I do if I'm sick?** Let your teachers know that you are sick. When you are feeling better, make up the assignments that are posted in Google Classroom. Check with your teacher about due dates if you are sick for more than three days.
