


### **Hybrid Phase**

- Each cohort attends school onsite two days each week, and participates virtually two days each week.





#### **Hybrid Phase**

Students in Cohort B attend schools on site on Tuesdays and Fridays. All eight classes are scheduled.

All students participate in class from home virtually on Wednesdays. Four one-hour classes take place each Wednesday.






### Daily Schedule

All classes will meet on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday & Friday. One cohort meets onsite, and the other participates virtually from home.





### Synchronous instruction begins on Monday, Sept. 14.


All classes meet on Monday, September 14.

- Students in Cohort B and Fully Virtual students will participate virtually by signing into each class at the scheduled class time.




## Will classes be synchronous, with video in the classroom?


# Are students expected to bring their personal chromebooks to school on days that they are present?


- Students are required to have a charged device with them each day. Students may bring their own device, or request to borrow a Chromebook from the school.

- There is a \$50 Chromebook fee associated with borrowing the device.



## What supports will there be for students?


- Students will have a study hall each day.

- Additional student contact time is scheduled each day from 2:00 - 2:40.






## What safety protocols are in place?


- All students and staff wear face coverings from door to door, which includes on the bus, in halls and in class.

  - Frosh Main Entrance






# What should a student do if he or she is sick?

If a student does not feel well, or is self-quarantining, the student may participate virtually, even if he or she was scheduled for in-person instruction. Students who participate virtually or onsite will be considered present for attendance purposes. As in previous years, if a student is sick, they should report their absence to the attendance office at extension 257. Students are permitted to return to school when they are fever-free for 24 hours.
