

WHAT DO ADMISSIONS OFFICERS LOOK FOR?

- Transcript Grades/GPA through Junior Year
- Academic Rigor and Growth
- Impact on school and/or community (Resume/Activities)
- Essays
- Letter(s) of Recommendation
- Test Scores* i.e. SAT/ACT
