

Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA)

The Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) of October 1987 has required that local education agencies have all buildings inspected for asbestos-containing materials and that an annual notice inform faculty, staff, and the community of the current status.

During the previous year, the following actions with regards to asbestos in the building have occurred:

1. The 6-month annual inspection occurred in August 2021
2. The 3-year inspection took place in January 2020
3. Asbestos containing was removed in June and July 2021

Licensed environmental consultants have been retained to perform the required AHERA inspections, provide updated monitoring, design response actions, and provide air sampling when required.
