Dear Parents and Guardians of RFH Students,

As you probably know, students will participate in several standardized assessments, some through the College Board and others mandated by the NJ Department of Education, throughout the 2024-2025 school year. These standardized assessments provide information about a student's curricular strengths and readiness for graduation and academic success in college. Please note the following planned schedule of standardized assessments that will be administered during the school day with the understanding that dates are always subject to change:

Assessment	Grade Level	Dates	Testing Time
NJ Graduation Proficiency Assessment (NJGPA-Fall)*	(by notification)	October 8 - 9, 2024	90-minute sections (2 sections per day)
PSAT	10 & 11	October 23, 2024	2 hrs. 45 minutes
NJ Dynamic Learning Maps (DLM) - ELA, Math & Science*	11	April 7 - May 23, 2025- specific dates TBD by teacher	varies greatly by section
NJ Graduation Proficiency Assessment (NJGPA-Spring)*	11	March 10 - 11, 2025	90-minute sections (2 sections per day)
NJ State Learning Assessment (NJSLA) - Math & English*	9	May 19 & May 22, 2025	90-minute sections (2 sections per day)
NJ State Learning Assessment (NJSLA) - Science*	11	May 20 - 21, 2025	60-minute sections (2 sections per day)

^{*}All students have an assessment requirement for graduation, as outlined by the <u>New Jersey Department of Education</u>. Students are expected to participate in these assessments. Make-ups for students who miss state assessments will take place during the regular school day in the week following an assessment administration. Sample questions and answers from the assessment and eventual student results are accessible through the <u>NJDOE New Jersey Assessments Resource Center</u>.

Additionally, students in Advanced Placement courses will take AP exams on specific dates from Monday, May 5 through Friday, May 16, 2025.

Additional details regarding changes to the school's schedule, bussing, and details regarding assessments will be provided at the appropriate time during the school year.
