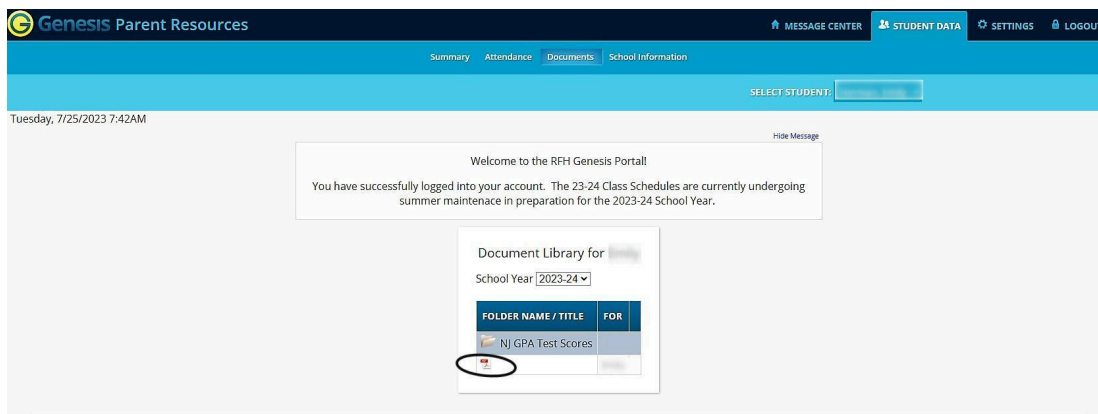

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Dear Parent/Guardian:

In March, your student participated in the *NJ Graduation Proficiency Assessment* administration to measure the extent to which they are graduation-ready in English language arts (ELA) and mathematics. The ELA component of the NJGPA assessed student graduation readiness based on grade 10 *New Jersey Student Learning Standards*. The mathematics component of the NJGPA assessed student graduation readiness based on Algebra I and Geometry standards. The NJGPA is required to be administered to students in grade 11 as part of the graduation assessment requirements adopted by the State Board of Education on September 8, 2021. A minimum score of 725 is required for each component (ELA and mathematics) of the NJGPA and was adopted by the State Board of Education on May 3, 2023. Graduation readiness is reported separately for each content component.

Your student's NJGPA Individual Student Report (ISR) is enclosed and is also available in the parent portal of Genesis. After logging in to the portal, click the "Documents" link to see a pdf of your student's NJGPA scores and breakdown. Please see the screenshot below.



If your student completed the assessment but failed to meet the minimum required score (725 or above) in one or both content components, alternate pathways are available to meet the graduation assessment requirement. However, please note, the alternate pathways are available only to students who attempted the NJGPA. The graduation assessment requirements for the classes of 2023 through 2025 are available on the [Graduation Assessment Requirements](http://nj.gov/education/assessment/requirements/) webpage at nj.gov/education/assessment/requirements/. There you will find the list of substitute competency tests and minimum required scores, along with additional information you may find helpful.
